What to do when a Veteran passes

1. Step one is the next of kin and or legal representative, under state law, to obtain the death certificate.
 2. The funeral director will assist with this. Obtain 4 or 5 notarized copies, as this certificate will be used for insurance, pension, bank accounts etc. Submit death certificate to the VA Health Resource center on South Detroit Ave, or call at 1-877-222-VETS (8387)
 3. Call Conn. Weissenburger Post at 419-471-0587 if the family of the deceased would be interested in color guard services or to speak to our chaplain Tom Gschwind.




